

THE OFFSHORE CHEMICALS REGULATIONS 2002 (AS AMENDED)

Dana Petroleum (E&P) Limited has applied to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy for a permit to use and/or discharge chemicals in connection with the Western Isles FPSO located in the northern North Sea.

In accordance with the requirements of regulation 7(1) of The Offshore Chemicals Regulations 2002 (as amended), copies of the application (including the Chemical Risk Assessment) may be inspected between 10 am and 4 pm on business days at Dana Petroleum (E&P) Limited, King's Close, 62 Huntly Street, Aberdeen, AB10 1RS until the close of business on 6th August 2017.
