

THE OFFSHORE PETROLEUM ACTIVITIES(OIL POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL) REGULATIONS 2005 (AS AMENDED)

Dana Petroleum (E&P) Limited has applied to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy for a permit to discharge effluents containing hydrocarbons in connection with the Western Isles FPSO located in the northern North Sea, as required under The Offshore Petroleum Activities (Oil Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations 2005 (as amended).

In accordance with the requirements of regulation 5A of The Offshore Petroleum Activities (Oil Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations 2005 (as amended by the 2011 Regulations), copies of the application may be inspected between 10 am and 4 pm on business days at Dana Petroleum (E&P) Ltd, King's Close, 62 Huntly Street, Aberdeen, AB10 1RS until the close of business on 20th September 2017.
